Call for Nominations

The Commission for Certification in Geriatric Pharmacy is seeking volunteers for appointment to the Examination Development Committee (EDC). Self-nominations are encouraged. Newly elected EDC members will serve a three-year term that commences on January 1, 2011.

Nominations Due September 10, 2010

The exam development committee provides an opportunity to work with peers to maintain the high standards of the CGP credential. As part of his/her role, committee members develop, evaluate and review test items according to psychometric standards as provided by our contracted testing company.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Nominee must be a board certified geriatric pharmacist (CGP) in good standing with CCGP
- Must be willing to attend at least two live meetings per year plus provide additional online review and test question development
- Willing to serve in a voluntary capacity, without remuneration
- (Commission will provide reimbursement for all reasonable travel and related expenses associated with Commission business.)

Term commences January 1, 2011. Appointees are eligible to serve two consecutive three-year terms.

Nomination Process 2010

A colleague may nominate the candidate. Self-nominations are encouraged.

- Nominations must be made in writing and must include the curriculum vitae of the nominee along with a letter of intent describing how the candidate meets the eligibility requirements as outlined above.
